Days 1-2 Travel days with overnight stops

Day 3 As we make our way into New York, we will stop in Jamestown at the Lucille Ball Desi Arnaz Museum. We'll spend time exploring the museum About the "The First Couple of Comedy" and have an I Love Lucy themed Lunch in the Tropicana Room. Then we travel to Penn Yan, New York, in the heart of the Finger Lakes region, for a 3 night stay. Day 4 This morning we depart with a local guide for a tour of Geneva which is on Seneca Lake. Day 5 We start our day with a tour of the 129 year old Smith Opera House in Geneva, one of the oldest operating performing arts theaters in the US. Next we'll visit a Mennonite Farm which produces maple syrup, sample Will be in order! Tonight we will enjoy a scenic dinner cruise on Lake Seneca aboard the luxurious Seneca Legacy.

Day 6 Before leaving the Finger Lakes Region, we'll tour the Rose Hill Mansion In Geneva, a Greek Revival Mansion built in 1839 by the Swan family. After lunch, we will travel to Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada for a 3 night Stay at the beautiful Marriott Fallsview Hotel & Spa. Every room has a View of the Falls!

Day 7 Guided tour of Niagara Falls with scenic stops in the area, the Falls Visitor Center, the Niagara Whirlpool, the Floral clock, and the Skylon Tower.
